Rainer Jueckstock is Executive Vice President, Tenneco and President, Powertrain. He has more than two decades in leadership positions with Powertrain's global operations.

Prior to assuming his current position, Jueckstock was Co-CEO of Federal-Mogul and CEO of Federal-Mogul Powertrain from 2012 until Tenneco acquired Federal-Mogul on October 1, 2018. During that time, he was also a member of the Board of Directors of Federal-Mogul and Co-Chairman of the Board.

Jueckstock joined Federal-Mogul in 1990 and has held several operations, sales and finance leadership roles within the Company, including Senior Vice President, Powertrain Energy, and Senior Vice President, Global Powertrain Operations, where he was responsible for all manufacturing locations and related activities worldwide. He was also Senior Vice President, Pistons, Rings and Liners; Vice President, Rings and Liners; Operations Director, Piston Rings, Europe; and Managing Director of the company's operations in Friedberg, Germany. Previously, Jueckstock was Sales Director for Rings and Liners, Europe; Finance Controller in Rings, Europe; and Finance Manager in Dresden, Germany.

Prior to joining Federal-Mogul, Jueckstock was a member of the German military. He earned a degree in engineering from the Military College at Zittau, Germany. He has also been a member of the Board of Directors of Plexus since 2013.
